## FOLK NEWS :-

As members or friends of the **Cellar Folk Club**, YOU are part of a broad network of individuals, organisations, clubs, festivals & events spread widely around the World, helping to preserve a culture, which may not get the "front page" headlines of other genres, nor the commercial support of many other forms of recreation, like footy ! ; but which gives millions of people, around the World, a chance to have fun, express themselves, & stay in touch with their cultural "roots".

Perhaps **Womadelaide** – being the World Of Music And Dance (WOMAD), now an annual event – is our best known example of this 'cultural movement' – but many other 'lower profile' events occur around Australia, which we should also support.

Around Adelaide – "Folk Clubs" come & go, on each day of the week, each with their own emphasis or focus (& None quite like the "Cellar" !!) A new club is starting in Bellini's Pizza Bar in Port Adelaide - & rumour has it, that the Hills Folk Club, which Ron Higgins had a big hand in organizing, some years ago, is on the move again ! (Not at the Aldgate Pump, any more ?)

For many – the atmosphere & incredible range of styles of music at a Festival is the way to go & the recent **Fleurieu Folk Festival**, now held each October at Willunga, South of Adelaide, is becoming one of the best. Coordinated by "friends of Stinky Creek", Annie & Pete Thornton, it's 3 days of amazing concerts, dances, & workshops, highlighted this year by appearances from **Eric Bogle**, **Danny Spooner**, **Keith Potger** (Stinky Creek #3), **The Fiddle Chicks** & some wonderful musicians from Victoria & elsewhere, including our own "**Triple Aspect**" with **Lesley Gentilin**, from Port Lincoln. Personal 'high-points' for me were Eric's great "Song-writing Workshop" (he doesn't do these very often !) & learning to play a tune on the Ukulele in about 20 minutes, with Victorian **Mike Jackson** !

There are a number of "massive" Folk Festivals, now held annually, around Australia, such as **Port Fairy** (March) & **Woodford** (January) – but none are quite as prestigious as the "**National**", held each Easter weekend in Canberra. This year South Australia is the 'feature state', which means, as well as the best performers from overseas & around Australia, many 'lesser known' SA performers might get a go, this year. It also means that residents of SA, pre-booking their tickets can save an enormous amount (Eg: Adults from \$88 – instead of \$200 at the gate ! – for the whole weekend !) Details are on [www.folkfestival.asn.au](http://www.folkfestival.asn.au) – or you can ask me, about any of these events.

I might even see you at some of them ? - Have a "**Folking**" Great 2009 !!
