**CD Review - 1988 – Colcannon**, reviewed by Ron Higgins

Back in 1988, Adelaide multi-instrumentalist, John Munro got together with friend Mike O’Callaghan to form a band for one night, to support the Battlefield Band, touring from Scotland, at a performance in Adelaide. They chose fiddler Lorna Parker & powerful singer & redhead Kat Kraus to complete the line-up. That performance lead to many requests for more & proved to be the formation of what has become one of Adelaide’s most popular & successful contemporary folk bands, COLCANNON. Successive versions of the band – which still includes John & Kat from the original quartet – have sold-out concerts across Australia & toured to Europe, Canada & USA, becoming one of Adelaide’s most successful ‘exports’. Recently, in Adelaide, all the members of the various generations of Colcannon combined to present a wonderful retrospective concert to celebrate their 20 years of great music.

This re-release on CD, of 10 songs from the original line-up is a fine showcase of powerful songs such as “After the Goldrush” (Neil Young), “Peaceful Easy Feeling”; “Prisoner in Disguise”; “Red Fox” etc. & includes a wonderful version of John McCutcheon’s memorable “Christmas in the Trenches” – all in Colcannon’s inimitable style.

*"..Although not present at the actual "birth" of Colcannon ( thank God, I have a weak stomach!), I have known the group from it's early infancy so to speak, and have watched them grow from a home-grown Adelaide good-time band to polished and accomplished international performers. There's been a few changes of personnel along the way, although surprisingly few given the years that Colcannon have been in existence, but no matter what the line-up, they have always given a stage performance that is never less than musically lively and involving and expertly and professionally presented. Although they already have more strings to their collective bows than a tribe of Comanche Indians ( vocally, instrumentally, harmonically etc. etc.), over the last five years or so they have added a strong collection of very good original songs to their repertoire, which to my mind helps set them apart from the majority of other groups. Mind you, it helps a lot that they do them bloody well....."*
